- Managers are responsible for ensuring that employees are aware of this policy and that it is enforced in their areas of responsibility.
- Employees are responsible for understanding and complying with this policy and reporting any concerns or violations.

This policy statement shall be displayed at our JTH office in Mackay and is communicated to employees during our Safety Induction, and accessible via our Company website. We will review this policy periodically to ensure it remains relevant to the needs of the Company and our clients.

This includes assessing our suppliers and partners to ensure they adhere to the same standards.
